ABOUT TAVERNE GUTENBERG

The « Taverne Gutenberg », is an association created in Octobre 2015 which aims to create encounters between artists and the public. It is located in a three-storey high building, in Lyon's city centre. The project was founded by Henri Lamy (painter from Lyon), Maïa d'Aboville (interactive designer), joined by Mathilde Corbet (artist in charge of the studios), Guillaume Sénéchal (project coordinator), Romain Weber (artistic programmer) and a team of dedicated volunteers.

In only a few months, the Taverne Gutenberg has curated dozens of events, and counts over 8,500 members.

CALL FOR PROJECT

THEME : MULTIPLE EQUATION

The political and diplomatic turmoil that the world and its population face today makes it essential for us to highlight the positive aspects of globalization, particularly through artistic and cultural exchanges.

Our next exhibit aims at showcasing a certain artistic syncretism, and how diversity constantly redefines the arts by providing different points of view.

The word «equation» symbolizes the human being as a whole, whereas «multiple» is in reference to the complexity of human nature.

With this theme in mind, we will be selecting artists who, throughout their work, display the influences different cultures can have on one another, or artists who draw their inspiration from multicultural backgrounds.

PERFORMANCE, MURALS, VISUALS ARTS, ART INSTALLATION, POETRY, CONTEMPORARY WRITING, INTERACTIVE ART.

Each spaces, rooms (measuring from 7 to 12 sq. meters), corridors and staircases are used to showcase works. The mediums are various : visual arts, plastic arts, digital art, theatre, dance, circus, music, writing, song, design, mapping.. and any creative form of expression.

Note : interaction with the public and visitors is well appreciated.



PRACTICAL DETAILS

The opening, will be held on the 2nd of February 2017 from 5:00 pm to 9.30 pm. There Artists must be present on the 2&3 for the opening shows.

During the opening show, the public is invited to wander through all rooms and floors.

An estimate of 1000 people is awaited during the exhibition.
